





DATA PROTECTION INFORMATION

Film, photo and sound recordings during the inauguration of HIBEF on 31 August 2021

European XFEL and HZDR are jointly holding this event to inaugurate HIBEF. During the event, images and sounds will be recorded for promotional purposes, that is, for reports on the occasion which will appear in print media as well as online (social media, organizers' websites, etc.). We are also planning to live-stream the event on YouTube where it will be freely available. Apart from a camera team, photographers will be present, all of whom may capture images of those present. The aim is to focus on the event in its entirety, but it cannot be excluded that individual guests may feature in the images. These images will be published in connection with the event and saved permanently for scientific/historical archiving on protected servers belonging to XFEL and HZDR.

The act of saving and publishing in the media is required to safeguard our legitimate interests in accordance with Art. 6, para. 1 lit. f) DS-GVO. In order to protect your fundamental rights and freedoms, an area behind the camera can be designated as a "retreat" where images will not be captured on any account. Please contact us in advance if you would like to make use of this option.

You have the right to file an objection at any time to the processing of your personal data that occurs in connection with our legitimate interests for reasons deriving from your particular situation. If, on consideration, the reasons for protecting your person outweigh those that speak for media publication, we will delete the images on the internet and neither post nor publish any further images relating to your person. Old print media will continue to be used; any objection you raise will, however, be taken into account when a new edition is to be published.

Please note that photo and film material published online can be accessed worldwide. It is possible for third parties to download, save and use the images published for unknown purposes – potentially in combination with other information available – even after they have been deleted. Via the search engine's archive function data may still be retrievable even though we have removed or changed the data.
