INSTRUCTIONS FOR AUTHORS - Please read

Invited presentations from the conference are to be considered for a special issue of *Journal of Physics G: Nuclear and Particle Physics*. We are looking forward to publishing your work. Please read this information sheet carefully to ensure your article can be processed smoothly.

Content of your article

J.Phys.G is a peer-reviewed journal, and so has different quality requirements for proceedings contributions than some other publication venues do.

All papers submitted for the proceedings will be refereed to the journal's usual high standards of scientific quality, whilst taking into account the conference nature of the submissions. This means that background papers and articles reviewing progress in a particular area will be considered more favourably than would be normal for a regular research paper. However, articles which have already appeared in substantially similar form in the peer-reviewed literature, or which are not presented in the style of a scientific article, cannot be considered. In case of doubt, please contact either the Guest Editors or the Publisher.

Permissions

If you are using figures from any previously published papers in your talk, please be sure to obtain the necessary written permissions from the original authors for you to include them, appropriately cited, in your proceedings contribution.

We will also require a signed "Assignment of Copyright" form from you prior to publication. This is a legal requirement and so please return your signed form to us as soon as possible. We will send you a form when we acknowledge your submission.

Length

Contributions should be as concise as possible. A maximum page limit has been agreed with the Organizers of 8 journal pages for each article. The Organisers can confirm the precise page limit for your particular article. Please try to respect the page limit the organisers have agreed. If a significant number of contributions exceed their page limits then the issue will exceed its total page budget and the organiser will be liable for the additional printing costs involved.

To estimate what the length of your finished article would be in our journal's printing style, please use the following guide:

Colour Figures

Unless you specify that you are willing to pay the fee, we will print all figures in greyscale / B&W in the printed versions. There is no charge for reproducing a figure in full colour in the online version. Current prices for printing colour figures are available on request from the Publishers.

Submission procedure

♦ What files to submit

When submitting your contribution it is important that you send, directly to us at the Journal, your <u>original source code</u>. Please note that PDF or PS files of your article are not sufficient on their own, as these file formats cannot be used in our production process.

We can accept any common variant of TeX or LaTeX. We can also accept MS Word files. Please do not forget to include your figure files as well. Our preferred graphics format is Encapsulated PostScript (EPS) although PostScript (PS) figures may also be submitted.

♦ How to submit (Online / WWW method)

The recommended way to submit is via our online form. The submission procedure is very simple and will take only a few moments.

Then click "Proceed" down at the bottom of the page to move to the next step. You can then upload your article's files, following the displayed instructions.

♦ How to submit (e-mail method)
