Projects and lectures The projects for the summer students are submitted by the research groups where the students will work during the summer. Once applications are received and participants are selected, a matching process is conducted. Financial support HZDR provides summer students with free accommodation, a stipend to cover daily living expenses, travel insurance and local bus tickets.
